

KCFC HALL OF FAME

Hall of Fame Nomination Committee: A five-member committee shall be appointed annually by the Executive Board, and if possible, be comprised of current Hall of Fame members still active with the club in the capacity as a board member (area director or assistant director) or coach (head or assistant). A minimum of one representative from Cheer should be included. The Executive Board shall appoint the committee no later than the regular March board meeting.

Qualifications required for Nomination:

1. Represent the values and beliefs of the club including the objective to foster friendship and clean, wholesome sportsmanlike conduct.
2. Not presently suspended or banned from participating in the program.
3. A minimum of ten (10) calendar years total service to KCFC (FCCJC); has distinguished themselves through significant contributions to the success of the club, and has been a positive influence to the youth of our community. This could include football/cheer board members, E-Board members, committee members, a coach, team/squad volunteer, official or a staff member.
4. An individual may be nominated without meeting the 10-year service clause for extraordinary circumstances.

Nominations: Any member in good standing as outlined in the Club Bylaws may submit a nomination to the chair of the Committee or to info@kcfootballcheer.org, which will in turn be forwarded to the committee chair. Nominations must be in writing and should communicate the qualifications or extraordinary circumstances regarding the nomination. All nominations will be considered by the HOF Nomination Committee.

Nominations Deadline: Must be received by the second Monday in September.

Hall of Fame Ballot Candidates: Candidates shall be any qualified nominees who receive a minimum of four votes of approval from the Hall of Fame Nomination Committee.

Selection of Hall of Fame Inductees: KCFC Executive Board of Directors shall vote on candidates submitted by the Hall of Fame Nomination Committee.

Ballots: A ballot listing all candidates and biographical sketches shall be distributed to Executive Board members in advance of their October board meeting, with ballots returned at the October meeting.

Votes required for election into the Hall of Fame: Approval by two-thirds vote of the Executive Board.

Results: The Executive Board will be advised of the results of the voting at their October meeting; Hall of Fame inductees will be recognized at the Annual Meeting in December.
