OVERVIEW

Practices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Will be at least one night a week, date/time determined by cheer coach · Practices will be mandatory August 1st, but some squads may opt to start practices in late Summer · Practices may be held outside until permits are approved by the school district
Cheer Camps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · All Spring/Summer Cheer Camps are optional but HIGHLY recommended · There are cheer camps available for every grade · Cheer camp information can be found on the KCFC website: Camps/Clinics/Events - Kansas City Football and Cheerleading, Inc.
Cheering for Football games	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Most football games are played at Heritage Park Football Complex: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ 16050 S Pflumm Rd, Olathe, KS 66062 · Flag football games will start mid-August and will be played at the Heritage Soccer Complex: 17255 Lackman Rd, Olathe, KS · Tackle football games will start the weekend of Labor Day · Football teams will be assigned by grade, and schedules are not available until mid to late-August
Costs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Cheer Dues: \$45 per cheerleader (applied to practice facilities) · Required uniform: approx. cost \$250-\$300 for new items (shell, skirt, body liner, briefs, poms, cheer bows, socks, shoes) · Camp wear will be purchased separately at a minimal cost · Used items may be available for purchase at the used uniform sale. *Information will come out in an email · Optional uniform items: Warm-up jacket, black joggers, hoodie and backpack · Misc items to consider: Cheer camps/clinics, squad pictures, spirit wear, sports bra
Fundraising and Scholarships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Fundraisers offered this year by the Area: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Trash bags, cookie dough, bow donation (all of these are optional) · Individual squad fundraisers are up to the discretion of the cheer coach · All area fundraisers (all cheerleaders' participation); helps offset the overage cost for practice facilities, end of the year awards and various other cheer items such as registration cost for Cheer and Dance competition (cheer only). <p style="margin-top: 10px;">Scholarships are available through KCFC by visiting the website: Cheerleading Scholarships - Kansas City Football and Cheerleading, Inc.</p>

Squads

Cheer squads are formed by grade, unless there are not enough registered in a certain grade to form a cheer squad, then grades may be combined. Final squad rosters will not be available until after the June 1st registration deadline.

Cheer Coaches

Coaches are volunteers who give their time, energy and dedication to organizing, teaching and maintaining their cheer squads. Each squad has at least one head coach and one assistant coach. All coaches are required to attend the Coach Seminar on rules, safety and stunting and undergo a background check. *Anyone interested in coaching will need to reach out to one of the area directors for more information.

CAMP/PRACTICE WEAR AND GAME UNIFORM

New Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Required pieces for camp/practice wear are area t-shirt, short, no-show white socks, white cheer shoes· Required pieces for game uniform are shell, skirt, body liner, briefs, socks, cheer shoes, cheer bows and poms· Optional pieces available for purchase: warm-up jacket, jogger pants, hooded sweatshirt, spirit backpack, any spirit wear items· Links will be sent to parents to purchase some cheer items on their own· Most camp/practice wear and game uniform item samples will be at the uniform fitting for sizing
Used Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Required and optional pieces will be available at 50% off of the 2025 prices. There will be limited availability, and all sizes are not guaranteed. Used items will be available at the used uniform sale which will occur after the uniform fitting date in June.
Options for Uniform Pieces	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Optional pieces are not required to be purchased, and cheerleaders may opt to use alternative jackets, hoodies, joggers and backpacks. PLEASE before using any "personal" cheer items, please have them approved by the cheer coach AND area director.
